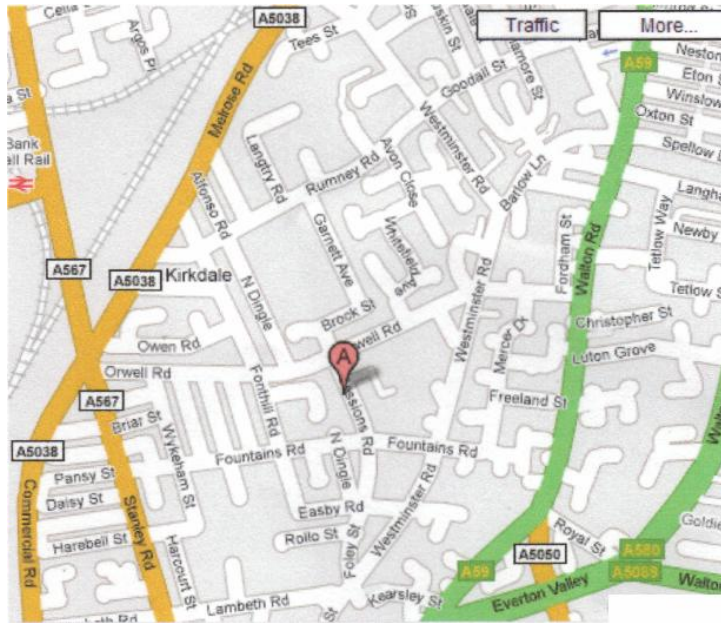


Dear Colleague

You are now probably aware that the Merseyside Police Table Tennis Club is relocating to new premises for the forthcoming season. The new address is:

About the venue:

The school is newly built and has just recently opened having replaced the old school building. It has a secure high fenced car park (40 bays) with key code entry to the school. Visitors to the school will have to press the access button on the gate to gain entry to the building.

The school is situated at the junction of Westminister Road and Fountains Road, Kirkdale, Liverpool4 although the map above shows a slightly different location

Matches will have to start at 7:30pm promptly so that they can be finished by 11pm.

The sports hall has modern non slip 'sport flooring' and very high ceilings. The high ceilings unfortunately negate the possibility of 'lighting' directly over the tables. However, the hall lights are again modern bright sport lights which have dimmer switch control. The lighting is similar to that found at tournaments and is of high standard. The sports hall will be divided into two rooms. One room, bigger than the area at Fairfield, will be used for single matches. The other room which is twice the size of the first room will be used for two matches when necessary. Yellow balls will be used at the venue. There is a large kitchen adjacent to the hall to be used for refreshments

We will have **five** teams playing this season. The home night for all matches will be on a **Monday** with two teams playing one week (one in the small hall, the other in the larger hall) and three teams playing the following week (two teams in the large hall and one in the smaller hall). Barriers will be used to create two separate playing arenas within the larger hall to ensure that the two teams playing in the same hall don't impact too much on each other.
